Planning Priorities for 2017-18

Planning Priority #1 - Positive Behaviour System

To develop a new school wide behaviour system to help students grow in positive behaviour, Citizenship and good character.

Strategies and Success Indicators

- This system will be based on current understandings of the importance of well-being and self-regulation for students.
- Our core values for behaviour are “Safe Kind Learners”
- We want to make it “easy to be good” at South Oaks.
- We will provide clear consequences and plans when misbehaviour occurs.

Planning Priority #2 - Literacy and Numeracy Skills

To improve the reading, writing and mathematics skills of our students.

Strategies and Success Indicators

- Grade level teacher teams determine effective strategies to increase literacy and math performance, using a variety of tools.
- Literacy and Mathematics support teachers provide additional support in the school each day, with flexible groupings..
- Divisional Reading clinician and Learning Coaches support classroom teachers and students for professional development.
- Update Literacy and Math resources, so our students have quality resources as they learn.

Planning Priority #3 - Deeper Learning Plan

To begin developing the 6C’s as major educational goals, starting with a focus on Citizenship and Character.

Strategies and Success Indicators

- The South Oaks Deeper Learning team will lead the development of Citizenship and Character education in the school.
- By June 2018, we will have a clear understanding of what Citizenship and Character mean at South Oaks and will see evidence of these competencies in our students and in the school in general.
